## **What is a Virginia Master Naturalist?**

A member of the Virginia Master Naturalist Program, a statewide corps of trained volunteers providing education, outreach, and service dedicated to the beneficial management of natural resources and natural areas within their communities.

**How do I become a Virginia Master Naturalist?** Certification, which is done through local chapters, requires 40 hours of initial training, and 8 hours of advanced training and 40 hours of volunteer service each year. The Old Rag chapter serving Madison, Rappahannock, Greene, Culpeper, and western Fauquier and Orange counties is accepting applications beginning June 26, 2010, for the 2010 session of classes.

**Where and when is the training?** Thursdays 6–9:30 p.m. August 12, 2010 through November 18, 2010. There will be five Saturday morning field trips in September and October at locations to be announced in class.
